

Overview

The University of Florida (UF) strives to provide effective safety and security communication with students, faculty, staff, and visitors. The program, branded as UF Alert, is consistently reviewed and measured for performance. A UF Alert is issued when one of three message types is warranted. When a significant emergency or dangerous situation is immediately occurring or threatening the campus community's health and safety, an *Emergency Notification* is issued. A *Timely Warning* is sent when the incident represents a serious or continuing, but not immediate, threat to the campus community. Messages are triggered by reports or confirmations of incidents within the university's Clery Act-defined geography. These boundaries include "reasonably contiguous" areas of campus and public sidewalks, and streets along the campus borders. A *Campus Safety Message* is relayed for criminal incidents or emergency situations that do not meet the legal standard for issuance for either emergency notifications or timely warnings under the Clery Act but reach a level that the university deems important to inform the public.

UF Alert has six subscription areas:

- System-wide The *UF Alert-Systemwide* service area provides notification to all locations regarding significant impacts to university operations or schedules.
- Gainesville The *UF Alert-Gainesville* service area includes the University main campus and other Alachua County facilities such as East Campus.
- Shands The *UF Alert-Shands* service area comprises the UF Health Shands Hospital complex on and adjacent to the university campus.
- Lake Nona The *UF Alert-Lake Nona* service area covers the UF Lake Nona Research & Academic Center Facility near Orlando, Florida.
- Jacksonville The UF Alert-Jacksonville service area supports the UF Health Center in Jacksonville, Florida.
- UF-Scripps The *UF Alert-Scripps* service area contains The Herbert Wertheim UF Scripps Institute for Biomedical Innovation & Technology in Jupiter, Florida.

Summary of Calendar Year 2024 UF Alert Messages

UF issued a total of 113 messages covering 49 separate incidents during the year. Of those messages, 43 notifications were sent for Jacksonville, 39 for Gainesville, 12 for Lake Nona, 6 for Systemwide, 10 for Shands, and 3 for UF-Scripps. Table 1, below, provides a message breakdown for each location. Additionally, Table 2 details the incident subject along with the number of associated messages, the date issued, and the specific UF Alert subscription area. Message content for each of the alerts is documented in *Attachment 1*.

UF Alert Users Training

Users of the UF Alert system, who are authorized to send messages, are provided regular education and training. UF Department of Emergency Management (UFDEM) conducts quarterly training, requiring users to log in and initiate a test message with staff from UF Strategic Communications and Marketing and the Lake Nona Research and Academic Center (RAC). UF Police Communications Operators (PCOs) complete a monthly test administered by the Police Communications Manager. PCOs must demonstrate proficiency on InformaCast as well as AppArmor. All new operators are presented with an initial overview training, outlining the UF Alert program and specific details of sending a message. Following an actual UF Alert, the sending PCO is provided with a quality assurance review of performance and message wording. The purpose of this regular testing and training is to address and improve the human component behind commencing an emergency notification. UF Health Shands, UF Health Jacksonville, and UF-Scripps are responsible for training authorized senders for their respective systems.

UF Alert Working Group

UFDEM coordinates a monthly UF Alert Working Group. Personnel from UF Information Technology (UFIT), UFDEM, UFPD, and Business Affairs Technical Services (BATS) convene to discuss UF Alerts sent since the prior meeting, performance of each message, status of device installations and maintenance, as well as other related topics. The Office of Clery Compliance conducts similar meetings specific to Jacksonville and Lake Nona areas.

UF Alert Annual Test Results



In accordance with UF's Annual Security Report, as well as the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act, a coordinated test is conducted a minimum of once per year. In 2024, all UF-Alert locations conducted their annual drill on the same day at organized times. The exercise activated all notification methods available for the respective areas. UF Alert-Gainesville and UF Alert-Lake Nona initiated text messaging, email, VoIP mass notification, social media, web, and RSS. UF Alert-Gainesville additionally sent a push notification to the GatorSafe

smartphone app. UF Alert-Scripps initiated text messaging, email, and voice calls. UF Alert-Shands initiated text messages, emails, and a push notification to the UF Health Protect smartphone app. UF Alert-Jacksonville employed text messages and email. Each test sent notifications directed to subscribers of their specific UF Alert subscription area.

SMS/Text Messaging

Text messaging is sent through an interface with the university's SMS vendor, AppArmor Alert, except for Jacksonville which employs Everbridge as a notification vendor. With the exception of UF Health Shands, the tests were successful with the vast majority of subscribers receiving the message. Reasons some individuals do not receive the messages include opting out of receiving messages from the vendor (vendor suppression list) or providing an invalid phone number, incorrect phone number, or



an international number. Tables 3-6 provide a detailed breakdown of delivery results from each area. Detailed performance reporting was not available from Jacksonville for this exercise.

Some UF Health Shands employees did not receive the SMS alert. Upon investigation, it appears that the number of cell phones reported in AppArmor were approximately 2/3 the expected amount. Table 4 shows the performance results of AppArmor based on the number of subscriber cell phones in the system at the time of the test. As of this report, the subscription number has returned to the expected amount. AppArmor customer support continues to investigate the issue.

UF Alert-Gainesville – 97% of subscribers were successfully sent a message in 3 minutes, 39 seconds.

Email

Tables 7-9 compare UF Alert email deliveries for the service areas against recent annual tests. Lake Nona only has three years of annual test data available for comparison. Email delivery reports for Jacksonville are not currently available. All areas except UF Health Shands successfully distributed emails in three minutes or less, and most within two minutes. Gainesville, Shands, and Lake Nona emails were sent via UFIT listservs while Scripps emails were transmitted by AppArmor Alert and Jacksonville emails were sent through Everbridge.

Some UF Health Shands employees did not receive an email, or received it after significant delay. Upon investigation, the UFIT-managed listserv performed appropriately, and transmitted the message to a UF Health Shands-managed listserv. Further investigation by UF Health Shands is in progress.

UF Alert-Gainesville – The UF Alert-Gainesville email distribution to 53,874 addresses was essentially completed within two minutes during the exercise.

Scripps – 99% of the 2,990 email subscribers were sent an email during the test.

VoIP Mass Notification and Voice Calls



Two areas, Gainesville and Lake Nona, use university VoIP devices for notification. Both locations sent test audio and text messages to their respective IP devices (telephones and speakers) maintained by Information and Communication Technology (ICT). At the time of the test, Gainesville maintained 16,800 IP devices connected to the InformaCast system while Lake Nona had 88 devices. Tables 10 and 12 detail performance of the test message for each location. Additionally, Table 11 compares performance against tests during previous years for Gainesville.

Scripps initiated voice calls to subscriber cell phones. Table 13 outlines the outcomes of those calls during the test. Calls were completed to 88% of their subscribers.

UF Alert-Gainesville – In about 4 minutes, 99% of VoIP devices in Gainesville successfully received the audio broadcast.

Social Media

Due to technology changes, UF Alert messages are unable to be automatically posted to social media. UFDEM is working to find solutions to address this. In the meantime, and when able, UFDEM staff manually posts UF Alert messages to the UF Alert-Gainesville and UF Alert-Lake Nona accounts. Messages for the UF Alert Drill were successfully posted manually to the UF Alert-Gainesville Facebook and X accounts, as well as the UF Alert-Lake Nona Facebook account. An error was encountered logging into the UF Alert-Lake Nona X account, but has since been addressed.

GatorSafe App

Users of the GatorSafe app, with push notifications enabled, successfully received the test message on their devices.

UF Health Protect App

Users of the UF Health Protect App, with push notifications enabled, similarly received the test message on their devices.

Web

The University's homepage provides a readily available resource to view UF Alerts for those internal or external to the institution. The message did post on the UF homepage (www.ufl.edu) during the test. The test alert additionally appeared on the sites of UFPD (https://police.ufl.edu/), and UFDEM (https://emergency.ufl.edu/).

RSS

An RSS (Real Simple Syndication) feed was automatically created when test messages were initiated, as is the case with standard UF Alerts. RSS feeds are available for each location, except Jacksonville and Scripps.

Areas for Improvement

The university works to improve the emergency notification process through a performance evaluation following each UF Alert activation. Enhancements, both technological and training, are continually occurring. Improvement items are tracked during regularly occurring UF Alert Working Group meetings. From the 2024 drill, there were three main areas noted for improvement on the main campus:

Issue – UF Health Shands employees did not receive a text during the test. Upon investigation, it appeared that a large number of recipients were not loaded in the AppArmor sending database. **Status** – In progress. AppArmor technical support is investigating, and it appears the issue was an error in the daily upload on the date of the test message. AppArmor is monitoring the daily uploads to verify the error does not happen again. A new test message will be scheduled to verify the issue is resolved.

Issue – UF Health Shands employees did not receive an email from the UF Health Shands listserv, or received the email with significant delay. The email message was sent through InformaCast to the appropriate UF-maintained listservs, which behaved as expected and passed the message to the UF Health Shands listserv.

Status – In progress. UF Health Shands IT is investigating their email exchange and listserv performance.

Issue – Several Blue Light Phones on the Gainesville campus did not activate their speakers during the test.

Status – In progress. UFIT is troubleshooting and resolving issues with BLP registration in InformaCast.

UF Alert Program Goals and Successes

Several long-term goals are in place to drive enhancements and the future direction of the University's emergency notification program. These aspirations are primarily developed and carried out through the UF Alert Working Group and UFDEM. Below are the desired improvements over the next multi-year period as well as recently completed goals:

Update of UF Alert website (complete) – UFDEM reviewed and updated the UF Alert website (<u>ufalert.ufl.edu</u>) with significant changes in 2023 and 2024, and continues to review the website for accuracy and functionality.

Adding RSS feed for Jacksonville and Scripps locations (ongoing) – RSS feeds have been created for Jacksonville and Scripps locations, and are in the process of being tested for addition to the UF Alert website.

Determine a mechanism for social media integration (ongoing) – due to external vendor changes, UF Alert messages are unable to automatically post to social media. UFDEM continues to post alerts manually to social media when feasible. A potential solution has been identified and is being explored.

Enhanced performance tracking of Jacksonville messages (ongoing) – UFDEM and Jacksonville will coordinate with the system's vendor, Everbridge, to explore available performance tracking results of messages.

Explore feasibility of single sign-on (SSO) for Scripps (ongoing) – UFDEM and Scripps will determine if SSO using Gatorlink login authentication can be implemented for their AppArmor Alert dashboard, factoring both budget and technology.

Update on shot fired report on Sorority Row

The University of Florida Police Department would like to provide additional information regarding the UF Alert issued in response to a report of a shot fired on Sorority Row of the Gainesville campus.

On Thursday around 11:15 a.m., UFPD received a call from a resident of Sorority Row who reported a shot had been fired through a closed window, striking indoor window shutters. The resident reported the incident had just taken place. As a result, UFPD treated the incident as an immediate threat to campus and issued a UF Alert.

Responding officers began searching the area for a potential threat and speaking to potential witnesses who reported they had not heard a shot fired. Additionally, some residents of Sorority Row reported having heard a "pop" sometime between 1:30 a.m. and 2:30 a.m. on Thursday.

After securing the area and conducting an exhaustive search, officers determined there was a time delay between when the incident happened and when the bullet was found by a resident of the building. UFPD is not aware of any injuries to any persons stemming from this incident.

Once officers determined there was no ongoing threat to campus, an update was issued stating it was safe to resume normal activities.

UFPD would like to thank its partners at the Gainesville Police Department for their assistance and response to this incident.

The investigation into this incident is ongoing. Additionally, UFPD has increased patrols in the area in response to this incident.

Clery Crime: Motor Vehicle Theft

Under the Clery Act, the University of Florida issues Timely Warning messages regarding Clery Act crimes which pose a serious and continuing threat to the campus community.

Over the last two weeks, UFPD has seen an increase in thefts of e-bikes and e-scooters, primarily on the east portion of campus. The majority of the stolen e-bikes/e-scooters were taken within 24 to 48 hours of being locked, and some were reported stolen within hours. Most of the thefts involved e-scooters locked with either a cable or combination lock.

UFPD is actively investigating and attempting to deter these types of crimes. On Monday, September 30th, patrol officers recognized a person known to officers for having previously stolen bikes and escooters at a bike rack on campus. When approached by officers, he was in possession of tools used to cut cable locks and admitted that he had intended to steal escooters. He was arrested and issued a trespass warning.

While these thefts are often crimes of opportunity, we encourage you to take steps to protect your belongings:

E-bikes and e-scooters are easy to steal because they are lightweight and compact. Traditional bicycle cable locks can be cut or tampered with using standard wire cutters, and e-scooters can be lifted through the locking mechanism. UFPD recommends using a metal U-lock to secure these items so that they cannot be lifted through the lock.

UFPD also recommends registering bicycles, e-bikes, and e-scooters in person at the Public Safety Building (1555 Museum Road – Gainesville) or with any UFPD officer on campus.

Lastly, if you are using a tracking device like an Apple AirTag, be sure to place it in a place where it is not easily removed.

Reporting criminal incidents to law enforcement is encouraged by calling 9-1-1 or through the GatorSafe app.

Criminal incidents can also be reported to UF Campus Security Authorities (CSAs), who are designated, trained, and mandatory reporters under the Clery Act when victims choose not to report to law enforcement.

Under the Clery Act, the University of Florida issues Timely Warning messages regarding Clery Act crimes which pose a serious and continuing threat to the campus community.

On May 26, 2024, at 7:50 p.m., University of Florida Police Department and Gainesville Police Department officers heard shots fired at the UF Park and Ride parking lot near the UF Department of Orthopaedic Surgery and Sports Medicine building on 3450 Hull Road. Officers were already at the parking lot in response to a large crowd that had gathered from a nearby block party. Officers on scene detained several individuals who had attempted to flee the area.

One person was injured during the incident and was treated for minor injuries. There were no reported gunshot injuries.

During this multi-agency investigation, two individuals were arrested on scene for illegal possession of firearms.

The joint investigation, which is being handled by UFPD and GPD, into this incident is ongoing. Additional information will be provided as it becomes available.

The University of Florida Police Department would like to provide additional information regarding the suspicious package that prompted the evacuation of Peabody Hall and the subsequent UF Alerts on Wednesday, Feb. 7, 2024.

UFPD received a call from a university staffer around 8 a.m. who reported an oddly taped cylindrical tube had been delivered by an unknown person to Peabody Hall, an administrative building. Out of an abundance of caution, personnel from Peabody Hall were evacuated by law enforcement.

An assessment by the Alachua County Sheriff's Office Bomb Squad determined the package did not contain any hazardous or explosive material. Once both agencies determined there was no threat to public safety, normal operations resumed at Peabody Hall around 10:15 a.m.
